VOUCHER PROCESS

1. Customer finds Participating Vendor via list at www.erc-vt.org/pellet-storage (note that the customer may change Vendors at any time in the process)
2. Vendor applies on customer's behalf for pellet storage voucher.
3. Customer receives pellet storage voucher.
4. Customer orders installation of pellet storage bin from Vendor.
5. Vendor submits voucher, invoice, and photos of installed storage bin.
6. Vendor receives a reimbursement check from the CEDF.
